



## Online Library Learning Resource Gets Upgrade and New Features

A free online learning resource, LearningExpress Library, has been upgraded and is now offering even more value to library users. The program offers math, reading and writing tutorials; ACT, SAT and AP test preparation; practice military and GED exams; eBooks and much more.



“We have provided LearningExpress Library to the customers of our partner libraries in Southern Maryland for years, but now it is even easier to use,” said Jennifer Falkowski, Information Services Manager for the Southern Maryland Regional Library Association. “The new 3.0 version of LearningExpress Library offers easier navigation, new interactive tutorials, multiple test modes for study and practice, recommendations for additional study and new GED 2014 products.”

Library users in Calvert, Charles and St. Mary’s counties have been able to use the service, which is located on the COSMOS website – [cosmos.somd.lib.md.us](http://cosmos.somd.lib.md.us).

According to Falkowski, the upgrade will affect those users who already have an account in LearningExpress Library 2.0 – the older version. “All users will need to create a new personal account,” she explained, “since existing logins for LearningExpress Library 2.0 will not work in the new version.”

“To finish any previously accessed tests in the last version of LearningExpress Library, library customers must log into LearningExpress Library 2.0 (link available through COSMOS) with their old credentials. The old version will eventually be deleted by the company – probably within the next few months. To create an account for the new LearningExpress Library 3.0, users must provide a name and email address, and create a password.
